This is in continuation of Ministry of Textiles' (SITP Cell) sanction letter of even no. dated 13th December, 2012. Consequent upon CCEA approved guidelines dated 8th November 2012, the land cost is excluded from the project cost. The project cost eligible under SITP is now Rs. 70.14 Crores in place of earlier approved project cost of Rs. 60.20 Crores. The Gol grant, being 40% of the project cost, changed from Rs. 24.08 Crore to Rs. 28.06 Crore.


I am glad to inform you that we have now approved one project, Hosliery Park, Howrah in your state.
